**Annex B**

Scale of the problem

*Prison population:* currently just under 65,000. (estimated population as at 01/12/2000 is 64,137). This is a decrease from the previous year. The vast majority are male, and includes just under 11,000 young offenders (male and females) aged under 21.

*Community sentences:* about 112,000 people commence sentences in the community annually.

*Around a third of men* have been convicted of a standard list offence by the age of 40. (Something more serious than a motoring offence).

*The peak age* of known offending is 21 for males and 16 for females.

By the age of 35, 62% of known male offenders and 69% of known female offenders had not been convicted of a crime for at least 5 years. Offending, statistically, tends to peter out as people get older.
